## **Vidya Pratishthan's VPNEMS Educators Secure Government Patent for Life-Saving Medical Device**



In a landmark achievement for Vidya Pratishthan's New English Medium School (VPNEMS), two dedicated educators have been officially recognized by the Government of India for their breakthrough invention. Mr. Swapnil Dattatray Darade and Mrs. Vijaya Prasad Shinde have been granted a Certificate of Registration of design for their innovative Foldable Dermatoscopic Imaging Device for Early Skin Cancer Detection.

The device registered under Design No.470605-001 features a compact and accessible design intended to revolutionize skin health monitoring. This Achievement underscores the evolving culture of research at Vidya Pratishthan, bridging the gap between classroom teaching and advanced medical technology.

According to the official certification from the Patent Office, the design registration was recorded on August 21,2025.Under the Designs Act,2000 the innovators hold the copyright for this design for an initial ten years ,which can be extended for an additional Five year period.
